Gäufelden – On November 15, 2025, RSV "Frisch Auf" Öschelbronn will host the UCI Artistic Cycling World Cup Final for Indoor Cycling Worldwide. The competitions will take place in the following categories: Single Women, Single Men, Pairs Women, Pairs Open and ACT 4 Open Class.

Artistic cycling is coming home: Artistic cycling has deep roots in our region, with clubs from the district and surrounding areas having produced numerous national and world champions in the past. Memorable events include the Indoor Cycling World Championships in 2000 in Böblingen and most recently in 2021 in Stuttgart. RSV Öschelbronn is very excited to host the UCI Artistic Cycling World Cup Final here and to welcome the best athletes from around the world.

Local star on the starting line: RSV Öschelbronn is pleased to have Simon Köcher competing in the Single Men's category. Simon Köcher was a multiple German champion during his school and junior years, and he was vice European champion in 2017 and 2018 in the junior category. In 2024, he also finished second overall in the World Cup Series.

Other well-known athletes from the region are also expected to compete: Lara Füller (World Champion 2024, Single Women from RKV Poppenweiler), Philipp-Thies Rapp (Single Men, World Championship second place, RV Tailfingen) and Jonas Beiter (RV Trillfingen).

For RSV Öschelbronn, a club usually known for road racing and track cycling, this is another prestigious event in artistic cycling since the German Masters Final in 2024, which the club organized with much enthusiasm and dedication. The club is excited to present spectacular top-level sports in an entertaining format and looks forward to welcoming many spectators and indoor cycling fans from near and far.
